

- Be at Camp Richardson at 12:20 on Sunday. Look for the band area in the front.
- PLEASE BE ON TIME. You have to park a little ways away from the performance area, so please allow some time to walk from your car.
- Please put sunscreen on your child and **be sure they have gone to the potty before they come to sit with the dancers. The younger dancers (girls) need to be wearing their tap shoes.**
- Girls' hair should be off their face in a bun, ponytail, two braids, two ponytails, or pulled back with a headband or barrettes if their hair is short. You can put bows in their hair. They need to wear reddish lipstick and a blush /bronzer that gives them some color on their cheeks- mascara if older.
- **THE DANCERS WILL NEED TO STAY TOGETHER IN A DESIGNATED AREA BEFORE AND DURING THE WHOLE PERFORMANCE. DANCERS CANNOT SIT IN THE AUDIENCE AREA WITH THEIR PARENTS. ONLY DESIGNATED HELPERS WILL BE ALLOWED TO SIT WITH THE DANCERS.**
It is very important that we keep the dancers together. Please leave your child with her designated group and go into the audience area so we can get the show running.
- This is an outdoor venue and will be a brand new experience for our youngest dancers (and many of you parents😊).
- We will start our show around 12:45 and it should take about 35 minutes. We need to be a bit flexible with our timing at these events.

- We are the only dance studio that lets ALL our dancers, from the littlest to our big girls, participate in these kinds of performances which are excellent opportunities to grow in their dance and performing skills. It is why our stars shine!
- BRING YOUR DANCER ALREADY DRESSED AS THERE IS NO REAL PLACE FOR CHANGING. *If you have a German, Austrian, or any Eastern European costume for your child, they may wear that, but if you don't happen to have one of those handy-*

Pre-School through 2nd grade: Any color leotard with an attached or separate skirt. Any color tights. Put their tap shoes on BEFORE they come sit with their class. They can wear a sweater or jacket as it might be chilly. Please remind your child that he/she will be sitting with her dance class friends at the Oktoberfest and that you will be watching him/her from the audience because only the dancers can be in the show.

3rd /4th/5th Grade : A black leotard (or black tank top and shorts) with caramel tights and tap shoes. We will give them their skirts at the performance.

Blue Skirt Waltz (Tuesday 6:15 and 6:25PM ballet classes): Need to be wearing their black leotards and caramel tights and BRING THEIR BALLETS SHOES - they wear their tap shoes first in the show. We will bring their "blue skirts".

Boys: Black or dark pants with a solid color shirt and tennis shoes with clean socks.

Middle School Girls: Black leotard or (or black tank top and shorts). Caramel Tights and tap shoes. Bring ballet shoes if in ballet.
