



- Parents and dancers will be required to wear masks and be socially distanced in the parking lot while waiting to check their child in.
- We would greatly appreciate it if you make sure your child has gone to the restroom at home before coming to class. Our restrooms are available - a staff member has to clean and disinfect after each use and we'd like to use every precious moment to dance.
- We will begin letting students in promptly at the beginning of class time. We cannot let any dancers in after class starts, so no late arrivals.
- Parents will sign a waiver at the door saying their dancer is symptom free and has not had any Covid exposure. **DO NOT BRING YOUR DANCER IF THEY ARE EXHIBITING ANY SYMPTOMS ASSOCIATED WITH COVID - 19.** Dancers will be temperature checked before entering the studio. Any dancer who has any symptoms or a temperature of 100.4 or above will need to be seen and cleared by a doctor and get a note before returning to classes.
- Dancers will enter one at a time and will use the touch free hand sanitizing stations that are at the entrances.
- Dancers and staff are the only people allowed to enter the lobby and the dance rooms.
- Dancers must arrive in their dance clothes. No changing at the studio.
- Dancers will bring their dance shoes, extra hand sanitizer or hand wipes and if dancing in multiple classes that day, their own water bottle in a small bag. Our drinking fountains have been removed. Please do not include any extra items in their bags.
- Dancers will put their dance shoes on at the entrance to the dance room and put their street shoes in their bags.
- Every young dancer will have their own appropriately distanced square to dance in. There are color coded x's on the edges of the floor for their bags.
- Older dancers will dance on the distanced x's on the floor and put their bags on the x's around the room.
- Class sizes are limited and are scheduled so that dance pods remain together.
- Class times are staggered so that only one class at a time is arriving.
- Floors and surfaces are sanitized after each age group's class that day.
- Dancers will use hand sanitizer and exit at the end of class via the side door, either up or down depending on where the class was held. Parents must be on time as dancers are not allowed to wait in the lobby or outdoors.
